

THE ORGANISATION AND THE COURSE OF THE COMPETITION

The main objective of the competition is to integrate Polish and Czech students, who need to solve Mathematical and Geographical tasks. English language is the compulsory language of the contest.

- The competition is aimed at teenagers aged 15-17.
- All the necessary information about the competition as well as about its basic documents are placed on the website of the school I LO in Bochnia. It includes the rules of the competition and the subject matter of the tasks at all stages.
- Each school enters 4 teams, with 5-6 students in each team, for the competition.
- The first stage of the competition consists in solving by the teams successive series of tasks. The tasks will be published by the organiser from November 2018 till March 2019.
- At the end of November, January and March on the website of the organiser there will be published tasks to be downloaded by the teams. The students solve the tasks and send them by email to the organisers. Each solution must be supported with suitable arguments and calculations. Giving only the answers is not awarded with points. The tasks solved correctly are awarded with points and the amount of the points which each team has received is added to its account.
- The teams have to send the solutions before the date which will be published with tasks. The solutions sent too late are not taken into consideration.
- On the website of the organiser there will be published ranking of the teams which will be updated after each stage. It will enable the students to monitor the effects of their work.
- The final stage of the competition will be held in Bochnia in May 2019. During this stage the teams will solve the last tasks.
- During the final stage all the points will be added and the best team and the best school will be selected.
